Indian Institute of Arbitration & Mediation offers membership to corporates, business groups, insurers, law firms, professional organizations, professionals and individuals. Members shall have one vote at the General Meeting of the Institute and for election of members to the Governing Council.

BENEFITS OF IIAM MEMBERSHIP:

- o Charter Member, Ex-officio Member, Corporate Member, Ordinary Member, Reciprocal Member and Associate Member shall have one vote at the General Meeting of the Institute and for election of members to the Council.
- o Reciprocal Members, who as per the reciprocal arrangement does not provide the right to IIAM to stand for election in its governing body, will have the right of an Associate Member. Otherwise the Reciprocal Member shall have the rights of an Ordinary Member.
- o Members will be eligible for special concessions or priorities to attend seminars conferences etc. organized by the Institute.
- o Members are entitled to special rates for participation in training programs, seminars, workshops on ADR organized by IIAM and other associate international institutions.
- o Members are eligible for 20% special discounted rates for arbitration and mediation services, which provides you a dispute resolution method which has the same legal status of a court proceedings, but which does not have its hostile atmosphere, rigid formalities and which takes care of your convenience and gives you total confidentiality.
- o Members can avail free advice to draft/select your dispute resolution clause and assistance in referring the matter for mediation or arbitration and assistance in selecting mediators or arbitrators.
- o IIAM brings you the latest legal position of ADR and DPM methods by way of its newsmagazines / periodicals absolutely free.
- o IIAM gives you the options to prevent and manage disputes through IIAM DPM services.



Categories of Memberships:

Ex-officio Membership: For present or retired Judges of the High Court or Supreme Court, Bureaucrats, Professors of Law with a teaching experience of 15 years in a Law College or University or Research Institute, Judicial Officers with 15 years experience in State Judicial Services. The membership fee is Rs. 15,000/- for life.

Corporate Membership: For distinguished persons, organizations, institutions or corporates. The membership fee is Rs. 5 lakhs for life. Those who become a partner of IIAM Community Mediation Service, the membership fee would be Rs. 3 lakhs.

Ordinary Membership: For any person who is not a minor or any organization, institution, corporate or association. The membership fee is Rs. 1 lakh for life or Rs. 25,000/- and yearly subscription of Rs. 10,000/-. Those who become a partner of IIAM Community Mediation Service, the membership fee would be Rs. 50,000/-.

Reciprocal Membership: For reputed organizations or institutions, including, but not limited to Chambers of Commerce, Trade organizations, Bar Associations, Professional Associations, which offer membership to the Institute on reciprocal arrangement accepting Ordinary Membership or Associate Membership of the Institute.

Associate Membership: For any person who is not a minor or any organization, institution, corporate or association. The membership fee is Rs. 25,000/- for life or Rs. 7500/- and yearly subscription of Rs. 5000/-.

TERMS OF IIAM MEMBERSHIP

The application for membership of the Institute shall be made in writing together with the applicable membership fees and deposited with the Governing Council who shall at their absolute discretion decide whether such applicant is to be made a Ex-officio / Corporate / Ordinary / Reciprocal / Associate Member of the Institute or not and if such application is rejected the said application money shall be refunded within a period of 30 days of such refusal without any interest.

The IIAM Member on requirement of utilization of IIAM services, shall utilize the same in accordance with the IIAM Arbitration / Mediation Rules in force.

Annual IIAM memberships shall lapse on non-renewal of membership fees.
