QUALIFYING ASSESSMENT PROGRAMME (QAP) for IMI Certification

The Independent Standards Commission (ISC) of the International Mediation Institute has reviewed the Qualifying Assessment Programme of

Indian Institute of Arbitration & Mediation (IIAM)

and has determined that it meets the Quality Criteria for assessment programmes qualifying mediators for IMI Certification. The Criteria are set out on the IMI portal at www.imimediation.org/criteria-for-qualifying-assessment-programs.

The IIAM QAP will have a dedicated space and link on the IMI web portal.

The providers of all approved QAPs are authorised to qualify mediators assessed by them under the terms of their QAP for IMI Certification, and therefore for IMI to grant those mediators IMI Certification, if:

- the dedicated process for qualifying mediators for IMI Certification via the IMI web portal has been followed
- the providers submit to the ISC all variations to their QAP
- the ISC is given all information to monitor compliance with the QAP Criteria to assure maintenance of high quality standards by all QAPs,
- the QAP provides the ISC with a report, annually, reviewing and critiquing its experience in qualifying mediators; and, and
- such directions as the ISC may give from time to time to maintain and enhance quality for all QAPs are promptly implemented.
