# IIAM to Set up Community Mediation Clinics in State

**Kochi:** The Indian Institute of Arbitration and Mediation (IIAM) is establishing Community Mediation Clinics in the state, with a view to providing a safe environment for people to voice their grievances.

The clinics provide trained mediators to facilitate conflict resolution. The system was launched for the first time by the Chief Justice of India in New Delhi in 2009.
