IIAM invites diploma, PG applications

The Indian Institute of Arbitration and Mediation (IIAM), Kochi, will conduct diploma/postgraduation programme in association with Hamline University School of Law, USA. This programme, which will specialise on arbitration, mediation and Intellectual Property, will be covered in three modules.

In the first module, the diploma course in dispute resolution will be conducted in Kochi from May 8 to 23. This course, offered to lawyers, law students, MBA students and other professionals, is a six-credit programme.

In the second module, a certificate programme in global arbitration law and practice will be conducted in London from June 19 to July 19.

This is a joint venture of Hamline University School of Law and School of Inter-

national Arbitration, Queen Mary University of London. This begins with a foundation course covering salient points of US arbitration law.

The final module will have a semester-in-residence programme at Hamline University from July 24 to December 20 with mandatory externship placement. The students also get the option to have dual specialisation on intellectual property.

The diploma programme is open to all

students eligible for graduate-level education. The other two programmes are open for Indian lawyers who apply for and receive admission to the Hamline LL.M programme for international lawyers. Students admitted to the programme under the joint venture will receive a substantial scholarship towards tuition.

Applications submitted by March 5 will receive expedited processing, review and admission decision to the tri-continental programme by March 20. Applications received after March 5 will be reviewed on a space-available basis.
